

Alternative Documentation Form

This form may be completed if you lack Proof of Purchase and are also unable to complete the Seller Verification form in lieu of Proof of Purchase. You must still submit Proof of Ownership and Photographs as detailed in the Claim Form, in addition to the information described below. By submitting this Alternative Documentation Request, you are not ensured of settlement benefits, but your circumstances will be considered by the Settlement Administrator in determining your claim. Any settlement benefits to be paid pursuant to this method of Proof of Purchase will be calculated using a figure of \$2.75 per lineal foot.

You Must Still Submit:

Proof of Ownership: Claimant must provide documents showing both: (1) you are the current owner of the property where the Decking is located; and (2) you owned it at the time the Decking was installed.

- Current Owner Documentation (common examples include dated property deed or title, property tax statement, mortgage statement, or utility bill); and
- Ownership at Time of Purchase Documentation (common examples include dated property deed or title, property tax statement, mortgage statement, or utility bill).

Photographs: Claimant must provide photographs that verify the color of the Decking and the amount of Decking you purchased. If submitted by mail, photographs must be at least 3 inches by 5 inches and have the property address and Claimant's name written clearly on the back.

- Color photographs must be sufficient to capture the entire deck. It is suggested that the photographs be taken from 4 (four) different vantage points.
- At least 1 (one) color photograph must capture a close-up of the decking boards. Before taking the photograph, write your name, address, and the date on a piece of paper and place the paper on the part of your decking to be photographed. The paper and its contents must be visible in the close-up photograph you submit. Date-stamped photographs shall not substitute for this requirement.

In lieu of Proof of Purchase, you must also submit:

- Additional Photographs:* Claimant must provide photographs of the perimeter of the decking with a tape measure along the edge so that size may be determined.
- Dimensional Drawing:* Claimant must provide a drawing of the deck that includes all perimeter measurements.
- Other Verifying Documents:* Claimant must provide any other documents that may help verify the type of decking purchased and the date of purchase. Examples include building permits for the home or deck showing the timeframe of the deck work, invoices for related decking items (e.g., railing, lighting, undersurface materials, lumber) showing the timeframe of the deck work, or invoices for related decking projects (e.g., contemporaneous landscaping around the deck).
- Claimant Statement:* Claimant must fully describe the circumstances resulting in the lack of Proof of Purchase and inability to complete the Seller Verification Form.
