

## **LEGAL NOTICE OF SETTLEMENT**

### **If you have an AZEK Deck purchased before 2013, you could get benefits from a class action settlement.**

A proposed Settlement has been preliminarily approved in a class action lawsuit involving certain AZEK Decking Boards that were sold from August 1, 2007 through December 31, 2012 (“historical AZEK Decking”). The class action lawsuit claims that CPG International, LLC and AZEK Building Products, Inc. (together, “CPG”) made misrepresentations about historical AZEK Decking Boards, which were sold prior to 2013. CPG denies any wrongdoing.

#### **Am I a Settlement Class member?**

You are a Settlement Class member if you are an individual who purchased historical AZEK Decking from August 1, 2007 through December 31, 2012, installed it on your residence in the United States, and you still own that residence. The following colors are part of this Settlement: Brownstone, Clay, Slate Gray, Ivory, White, Fawn, Kona, Sedona, Tahoe, Acacia, Morado, and Redland Rose. Product purchased after December 31, 2012 is not historical AZEK Decking Product even if the color is listed above.

#### **What does the settlement provide?**

If you are a Settlement Class member, you may be entitled to receive 10% of what you paid for historical AZEK Decking, not including what you paid for labor and installation or other deck parts. Certain set-offs and/or reductions may apply.

#### **How can I obtain benefits?**

Submit a Claim Form. Claim Forms can be found at [www.azekdeckingsettlement.com](http://www.azekdeckingsettlement.com) or by calling 1-855-229-7149. You may submit the Claim Form electronically.

#### **What are my legal rights?**

If you are a Settlement Class member, you may remain in the class by doing nothing. Class members are bound by the release and judgment in this lawsuit. If you are a Settlement Class member but do not want to be part of and legally bound by the settlement, you must exclude yourself from the class by December 15, 2017. If you do not timely exclude yourself from the Settlement Class, you will waive legal claims addressed by this settlement. If you are a Settlement Class member but want to contest the settlement, you may file objections to the settlement with the court by December 15, 2017. You may not object to the settlement if you exclude yourself from the class. The Court will hold a hearing on February 20, 2018 to consider whether to approve the settlement and a request for attorney's fees up to \$5.25 million, plus a payment of \$5,000 for each named Plaintiff. You or your own lawyer may appear at the hearing at your own expense.
